Community Development Mission

• "[. . .] provide quality affordable housing programs; community and economic development programs and services; and homelessness prevention programs throughout Hamilton County [. . .]"

What is Affordable Housing?

- Safe, sanitary, appropriate size housing provided by 30% of household income
- Recent National Low Income Housing Coalition shows that in order to afford a two-bedroom apartment in Hamilton County, an individual must earn \$14.04 per hour working 40 hours a week (link: https://nlihc.org/oor)
- Seven of 10 of the major industries in the County pay between \$9.16 and \$13.59 per hour, representing 136,000 people

County HUD Funds


3 Entitlement Grants

- Community Development Block Grant \$3.3 million
 - Increases with more communities participating
 - Formula based on age of housing stock, income levels, age of residents, economic viability of community
- HOME Investment Partnership Program \$1.4 million
- Emergency Solutions Grant \$270,000

Affordable Housing Needs in County

- Study commissioned by Local Initiatives Support
 Corporation (LISC) via Xavier University Community
 Building Institute (CBI) in 2016
 https://www.xavier.edu/communitybuilding/documents/Housing_Affordability_Hamilton_Co_rev03.02.2017.pdf)
- Study showed 1/3 or 110,000 households are cost burdened – paying more than 30% of income for housing; of those households, 50% or 51,685 households pay 50% or more of their income for housing
- Study shows need for 40,000 units for households making \$25,000 or less

County Programs Using CDBG \$

Legal Aid – Foreclosure Prevention

- 2017 \$30,000 total
 - \$5,000 counseling for 10 HH
 - \$25,000 emergency mortgage assistance for 12 households
- 2018 to date \$80,000
 - \$20,000 counseling for 40 HH counseling
 - \$50,000 emergency mortgage assistance for 20 households

- Home Improvement Repair Programs \$15,000 each
 - Forest Park, Springdale, Greenhills
- Working in Neighborhoods Counseling Services

County Programs Using HOME \$

Working in Neighborhoods – Down Payment Assistance

HOME Investment Partnerships Program

- Affordable housing for low to moderate income residents.
- Programs include acquisition, rehabilitation and new construction of housing.
- Example: Maple Knoll Village, moderate rehab of 149 senior housing units for elderly adults ages 62+ with no more than 60% AMI.
 - \$350,000 in HOME funds
 - Over \$17 million total project cost

2016-2018 NSP and HOME Projects


- In 2016, County awarded \$1.6 million in HOME and Neighborhood Stabilization Program funds to leverage \$24.7 million in affordable housing development
- In 2017, County awarded \$900,000 million in HOME funds to leverage \$11.3 million in 243 units of affordable housing development
- In 2018, County awarded \$1.4 million in HOME funds to leverage \$19.1 million in 77 units of affordable housing
- Overall, County HUD funds of \$4 million is leveraging \$66.7 million in nearly 450 units of affordable housing
